**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** To be used in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. MAY CAUSE SENSITIZATION. CAUTION-EYE IRRITANT. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, water-proof gloves, shoes, socks and eye goggles when handling, or mixing/loading the product and during all clean-up/repair activities. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

**FIRST AID:**

IF SWALLOWED - Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING - Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED - Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF IN EYES - Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

GENERAL – Seek medical attention immediately if irritation or signs of toxicity occur and persist or are severe. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you, when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**STORAGE:** Store in the refrigerator at 4°C for up to 2.5 years. Store container upright and keep tightly closed when not in use.
